RECYCLING DO'S & DON'TS

When mixed in with other recyclables in our carts, plastic bags and films jam conveyor lines at the recycling facility resulting in costly shutdowns and they don't get recycled. To improve our community's recycling program, please do not put plastic bags or film in your recycling cart. If you

must use a bag to set out recyclables, use a paper grocery bag that can be recycled.

You can drop off plastic bags at your local grocery store for recycling. They'll be sent to a different facility with equipment that can process these materials for recycling.

VILLAGE REMINDERS

Dogs *Ordinances Article 1. Section 205.* Dogs must be on a leash and accompanied by their owner. Running at Large is Prohibited.
205.230. Habitual barking and disturbing the peace is a public nuisance.
215.020 Dog owners shall promptly clean up solid waste from their dog on both private and public property. Solid waste accumulation on private property is prohibited including where there is a fence.

Yard Maintenance

215.040. Yards must be frequently and promptly maintained. Leaves must be removed.

No Parking Signs

If you are hosting a party this season, please request No Parking signs from Officer Hadzic. Please return the No Parking signs to the Community Building at 1

Missionary Ridge the day after your party.

Street Parking prohibited 3:00 AM to 5:00 AM.

Please ask your guests (most commonly college age visitors) to park their cars on your driveway overnight. This makes it more difficult for trespassers and door handle flippers to vandalize your cars. Please keep personal items including personal protection items out of sight and lock your vehicles.

Crime deterring lighting.

We are told that low landscape lighting that illuminates the area immediately around the residence is best. Sometimes residents put overly bright lights on their property, and that can cause harsh shadows that enable trespassers to hide, as well as making it more difficult for night time police patrols to see people on the property.

If you have landscape lighting, please baffle the lighting so that it does not illuminate past your property line.
